Another Important Capture by De Rodas—Progress of the War—An American Colonel Killed—The Cholera.

HAVANA, June 25.—Captain-General DE RODAS telegraphs to Havana that he has captured the second cargo landed by the steamer *Upton* on her return from Aspinwall. It is more valuable than the first.... MONTANER'S column had killed twelve of SANGUILI'S band, including an American Colonel. The reaction in the interior was the cause of many outrages. The insurgent ORTEGA and his family were on the road to surrender when they were captured. Two other men, in attempting to surrender, were caught and hanged and their families outraged. Parties are forming who resist the conscription and refuse aid to the revolutionists.... The number of cholera cases and deaths from that disease are daily growing less, and no fears are entertained of an epidemic at present.
