Bembeta Invades the Western Department with 600 Insurgents-Cool Reception-Capture of a Wrecker.

HAVANA, June 30.—The Diario states that the insurgent BEMBETA, with a force of 600 cavalry, had invaded the jurisdiction of Sancti Spiritus for the purpose of inciting the inhabitants of the Western Departments to rebel against the Spanish authorities. Findthe houses deserted and the ing people flying from the insurgents, his forces became demoralized. Cholera broke out among BEMBETA's troops, and he was compelled to return to the Puerto Principe region. Columns of Spanish troops have been sent against BEMBETA from different points, and are now purshing him. No engagement has yet taken place. BEMBETA failed utterly to obtain the assistance of the country people. The Spanish gun-boat Orillo captured the English sloop wrecking John Gray, from Nassau, on Cayo Moro. The captain and crew were negroes, and the sloop was without papers.
