

CUBA.

A meeting of prominent slaveholders was held yesterday, in Havana, at which Captain-General DE RODAS presided, to discuss the subject of abolishing slavery in Cuba. A Committee of twenty-five was appointed to devise a plan, and to initiate the work by putting their scheme in execution, when it is to be submitted to the Cortes for approval. An election for Deputies to represent Cuba in the Cortes, has been ordered by the authority of the Spanish Government, to be held before the end of August. The Cubans of the Camaguay District, who have been in rebellion and become loyal, are said to be at work on their plantations, and to have received arms to defend themselves against the insurgents.
