## **Destruction of Canceled Bonds—Information from Cuba—The Practice-Ship Savannah at Madeira—Reopening of the Interminable McGarrahan Case.**

WASHINGTON, Aug. 22.—The canceled bonds representing the reduction of the national debt, amounting to \$129,802,650, having been counted and entered on the books of the various Treasury Bureaus through which they are required to pass, have been finally turned over to the Committee designated to superintend their destruction, and were today committed to the flames.
