Cuba—Cholera Increasing—The Steamer Lillian.

HAVANA, Aug. 5.—The cholera, which broke out here recently, has considerably increased. There have been as many as thirty deaths a day....The steamer *Lillian* has been purchased at Nassau, and has arrived at Nuevitas.

Reported War Between San Domingo and Hayti—A Haytian Loan.

HAVANA, Aug. 5.—Advices have been received from San Domingo that war between the Governments of San Domingo and Hayti is imminent. President SAGET, of Hayti, aids Ex-President CABRAL, of San Domingo, and BAEZ aids the followers of the late President SALNAVE. The Salnavists had attacked the northern frontier. A loan of two millions of dollars has been projected by Hayti, to be redeemed in currency.

Porto Rico—New Maritime Regulations—Amnesty for Political Offenders.

ST. JUAN, Aug. 1, via HAVANA, Aug. 5.—According to the new law in operation in the Island of Porto Rico, all vessels arriving here with cargoes are required to pay \$1 for each ton brought, and vessels arriving in ballast to take sugar are required to pay \$30....Gen. BALDRICH has remitted the sentences of banishment on many natives who were compromised in the Cuban rebellion.
