### **The Situation—Destruction of Property —A Government Loan—Control of Charitable Institutions.**

HAVANA, Sept. 4.—The rebels have burned San Jose plantation, the property of the insurgent Gen. PORRO and Mr. PRICE, United States Consul at Nuevitas....The Intendente has effected a par loan of three millions with the Spanish Bank at five per cent. interest, although the bank rate of discount is eight per cent. This proves the confidence of the financial classes in the Government of the island....Charitable institutions are passing under the control of the municipal councils in all parts of the island.... Señor ARANTAVE, Inspector of Telegraphs, has returned from Spain, and resumed charge of the wires.
