West Indian Affairs—Reverses and Suffering Among the Insurgents of Cuba—Destruction of Commerce—San Domingo.

HAVANA, Sept. 7.—Col. ACESTA reports the

killing of forty insurgents in the Caunao region. Gen. Caro is reported to have surrendered in form. There is much hunger and misery among the insurgents....Commerce in the West Indies is paralyzed on account of the European war.... Advices from San Domingo to Aug. 20, received here, state that the position of President BAEZ was critical. Hungria, the Minister of War, had

resigned.
