THE PROPOSED SALE OF THE ISLAND—THE STATEMENTS OF FALSE REPORTING JOURNALS DENIED.

MADRID, Monday, Nov. 7, 1870.

The *Correspondencia* newspaper denies the statements made in *The New-York Herald* on the 15th ult., and *The Sun* on the 19th, relative to the sale of Cuba. [The *Correspondencia* is the organ of Señor Morel, the Minister of the Colonies, and its utterances on this question may therefore be regarded as official.] The journal adds that the Spanish people would not permit the sale of Cuba to the United States or any other nation, on any terms.
