

OUR CUBAN CORRESPONDENCE.—The Cuban correspondence which we publish on another page shows that the reported slaughter of three hundred Cubans by the volunteers, as an act of retaliation for the shooting of Señor Castañon in Key West, was greatly exaggerated.
