**Another Expedition Under General Goicouria—  
A Portion of the Men Captured and Executed by the Volunteers—The Chinese Joining the Insurgents.**

HAVANA, Feb. 18, 1870.

The schooner Herald, from Nassau, recently landed a party of thirty-six filibusters at Gibara, under the command of General Goicouria. They were attacked by the volunteers, who killed seven and captured four of the expedition. The prisoners were executed at Holguin on the 14th inst. It is reported that the survivors are in the Sierra Socarrena in a famished condition. The outlets of the Sierra are guarded, and the capture of the entire expedition is considered certain.

A band of Chinese insurgents have appeared in the Sagua jurisdiction. On the 15th inst. they burned the Peralta warehouses, with 800 hogsheads of sugar, and killed the clerk and watchman.
