The schooner Herald, from Nassau, recently landed a party of thirty-six fillbusters (at Gibers, under the command of General Golocuris. They were attacked by the volunteers, who killed seven and captured four of the expedition. The prisoners were executed at Holguin on the 14th inst. It is re-

ported that the surrivors are in the Sierra Socarrena in a famished condition. The outlets of the Sierra are guarded, and the capture of the entire expedition is considered certain.

A band of Onlinese insurgents have appeared in the Sagua jurisdiction. On the 15th inst. they burned the Peralta warehouses, with 800 hogsbeads of sugar, and killed the clerk and watchman.
