

THE KEY WEST TRAGEDY.

In reference to the shooting affray that was mentioned in the HERALD of February 1, the following explanatory telegram has been received in this city:—

KEY WEST, Feb. 1, 1870.

The duel between Castañon and Reyes (editor of *El Republicano*) did not take place, because the authorities interfered. Another Cuban challenged Castañon, but the latter would not accept. The Cuban then insulted Castañon, who fired a shot at him; in returning the fire Castañon was killed. Another Cuban and a Spaniard, who were present, exchanged shots, and were both slightly wounded. All remains quiet.
