

OUR CUBAN NEWS.—The latest intelligence from our correspondents in Cuba is most favorable to the cause of the revolutionists. Two expeditions recently left Nassau for Cuba, with men, arms and ammunition, and there is every reason to believe that they have proved successful. A steamer is reported to have landed on the north coast of the island with arms and ammunition. In the neighborhood of Santiago de Cuba the Cubans are up and doing. A greater degree of activity is noticeable in the conduct of the revolution than has previously characterized it. The patriots have also learned the advantages of silence, in keeping to themselves their proposed movements, and not to blazoning them forth for the benefit of their enemies. Let results tell their own story. The prospects for Cuba, taken altogether, are brightening.
