General Goyenche's Return to Puerto Principe—Reported Victory over the Insurgents.

HAVANA, Feb. 6, 1870.

General Goyenche returned to Puerto Principe on the 23th ult. A letter announces that he defeated the rebels and captured two pieces of artillery and many prisoners. It is reported that a son of Cespedes, eleven years of age, is among the captured prisoners.

Seven houses and several sugar fields have been destroyed by incendiaries on the line of the Remedios and Caibarien Railroad.
