**Escape of General Goicoechea—Reported Slaughter of Insurgents—A Judge Confined in Morro Castle for Releasing Freemasons from Jail.**

HAVANA, March 12, 1870.

General Goicoechea and some of his followers have escaped from Camaquey and gone towards Las Tunas.

The government troops in the vicinity of Trinidad have recently killed one hundred insurgents.

A judge yesterday illegally released the Masons who were in jail. Captain General de Rodas thereupon placed the judge in Morro Castle and ordered the Masons to report themselves to the city jail as under arrest.
