The Havana Press on the Recognition of Belligerent Rights to the Insurgents by the United States.

HAVANA, March 19, 1870.

The *Prensa* and *Diario de la Marina* have editorials to-day on the unfriendly comments of the American newspapers on affairs in Cuba. They both intimate that if the American government would send commissioners here they are positive that such commissioners would disprove the assertions lately made by General Quesada about the condition of the rebellion and other matters, and America would discard forever the question of the recognition of belligerent rights to the insurgents.
