Departure of the Captain General for Nuevitas—The Cuban Turncoat Arango Accompanies Him.

HAVANA, March 20, 1870.

Captain General de Rodas, accompanied by Secretary Fernandez and General Ferrer de Cauto, of the *New York Cronista*, and his full staff, sailed this afternoon for Nuevitas. On his arrival there he will proceed to Puerto Principe. The length of time he intends to be absent is not known. General Napoleon Arango, late of the rebel army, arrived in Havana this morning and sailed with the Captain General, in order to aid him with his influence in the restoration of peace.
