Successful Landing of an Expedition Near Nuevitas—Hard Fighting Near Manati—The Spaniards Beaten—Cholera.

Advices from Nuevitas up to the 20th inst. state that filibusters had effected a landing near Nuevas Grandes. Troops were telegraphed for from Puerto Principe. They arrived at Nuevitas on the 19th and were immediately started in pursuit of the invaders. Two gunboats had sailed for Nuevas Grandes to cut off the retreat by sea if any was attempted.

Hard fighting was reported near the town of Manati. No details had been received. The troops must have lost heavily, as the Spaniards at Nuevitas seemed much depressed.

Cholera prevails to a serious extent at San Miguel and Baga.
