Reported Resignation of General Jordan, of the Republican Army.

HAVANA, March 2, 1870.

Private letters announce that General Jordan has resigned the command-in-chief of the insurgent forces, and that Bernabe Varona, alias Bembetta, has been appointed in his place. The statement has not yet been confirmed.

The troops recently discovered two cannon, which had been recently buried by the rebels near Ramon, and brought them to Santiago. They had a severe engagement with the rebels, who endeavored to recapture the guns, but were repulsed.

The carnival has been unusually quiet. No disturbance whatever has occurred.
