Reported Surrender of Another Party of Insurgents.

HAVANA, March 8, 1870.

A party of ninety insurgents, commanded by Arredondo, and consisting of part of the force of Jesus del Sol, left the Cienega de Zapata and have arrived near Guines, forty miles from Havana. The troops from all parts of the surrounding country are marching against them.

The Havana markets are unsettled, on account of the fluctuations of gold in New York.
