A Vessel Burned at Sea—Surrender of Insurgents at Cannao.

HAVANA, April 16, 1870.

The brig *Gladisteur* arrived to-day. She reports having met at sea the schooner *John Limeburner*, of Brookville, loaded with molasses, on fire and abandoned. The schooner sunk shortly after the brig met her, and the fate of her crew is unknown.

An official account has been received of the surrender of seventy-six insurgents at Cannao. Two insurgents of Goicouria's forces surrendered at Holguin.
