**A Small Instalment of Truth from the Captain General—The Patriots on the Offensive—Invasion of the Bayamo District—Capture of Capitanía del Horro and Other Successes.**

HAVANA, April 20, 1870.

General Valmaseda has issued two proclamations announcing the entrance of the insurgent forces, commanded by Modesto Diaz, into the Bayamo district after a fight.

The Canto Abajo insurgents attacked, captured and burnt Capitanía del Horro, after a severe engagement, during which thirty-five volunteers and forty insurgents are reported to have been killed. The Spanish wounded escaped miraculously.

Six Spanish battalions are pursuing the insurgents to prevent them entering the Sierra.

Another body of insurgents are operating this side of Canto.

The steamship Missouri arrived this morning from New York.
