Why General Goicouria Was Executed— More Butcheries by the Spaniards—Cuban Successes—Disorganization in the Spanish Forces.

HAVANA, May 7, }
Via KEY WEST, May 8, 1870. }

General Goicouria was tried by court martial last evening and was garroted this morning to satisfy the volunteers and open the way for the return of De Rodas. The Captain General is much annoyed at his failure to extinguish the insurrection in the Camaguey district. The Spaniards have' butchered families at Puerto Principe in revenge for the escape of their Cuban relatives to rejoin the patriots in the field. The patriot forces command the entire Cinco Villas district and occupy the eastern portion of the Sant Espiritu jurisdiction. The Spaniards have been routed in every direction and are now closed in at Manzanillo, Trinidad, Cienfuegos, Moren and Santiago de Cuba. The work of devastation has been fairly inaugurated in the districts of Colon and Sagua. The Spanish authorities are unable to prevent the disorganization of their adherents, though they are making every effort to rally their forces and give an appearance of harmony to the situation. With the financial employés the cry of "Sauve qui peut" is general, and they seize everything within their reach. The city of Havana is tranquil.

Another View of the Situation—Reported Sur- render of Cubans.

HAVANA, May 9, 1870.

Official despatches from Puerto Principe represent that the insurgent army has disappeared from the Camaguey district. Gonzalo Varona, chief of staff of the rebel General Agramonte, and Paymaster Morales have been captured and executed. A party of sixteen armed insurgents came to Puerto Principe and surrendered.

The gunboats at Guajaba Key have discovered and destroyed another rebel craft. No one was on board.

The United States steamer Tuscarora has arrived here to convoy the Dictator to Key West.
