**Spanish Report of a Fight—Three Pieces of Cannon Captured and Ninety Patriots Killed—Only Two Spaniards Wounded.**

HAVANA, May 12, 1870.

Captain General De Rodas to-day telegraphed from Puerto Principe to Havana that Montaner's column had a fight with the insurgents on the road from Santa Cruz to Puerto Principe. The Spaniards captured three pieces of cannon and killed ninety of the enemy. The Spanish loss was only two wounded. The captured cannon are now at Puerto Principe.

HAVANA, May 12, 1870.

The sugar market is buoyant; sales were made to-day on the basis of  $8\frac{1}{4}$  a  $8\frac{1}{2}$  cents per arroba for No. 12 Dutch standard. Exchange on London,  $15\frac{1}{2}$  per cent premium; on Paris,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  per cent premium; on the United States, sixty days' sight, in currency  $9\frac{1}{4}$  per cent discount.
