

**EXECUTION OF GENERAL GOICOURIA.**—Our cable news from Havana last night informs us of the execution of the Cuban General Goicouria. The General was brought to Havana in the steamer Triunfo on Friday and placed in jail. Yesterday he was tried by a "verbal" court martial and sentenced to be garroted. It is hardly necessary to add that the sentence was carried out. At eight o'clock last night the venerable old Cuban, who, since the struggle for the independence of Cuba was inaugurated, fought against Spanish oppression, was executed in obedience to the sentence of a court called together with such indecent haste that its act cannot be regarded other than as "bloody, wolfish, starved and ravenous."
