

THE CUBAN LOBBY INVESTIGATION.—The upshot of the investigation into the alleged attempt to bribe Congress by Cuban lobbyists seems to be that such attempts were made by prominent members of the Cuban Junta through well known Washington lobbyists, but that any succeeded is doubtful.
