## **A Report Corrected—De Rodas Declines Reinforcements from Spain.**

HAVANA, July 23, 1870.

The report published in the New York journals of the 31 inst. stating that in Remedios the volunteers had assassinated forty-two of the citizens of that place, and that the ladies in the city were obliged to work on the streets in chain galls, is a pure invention. Nothing of the kind has occurred. American merchants and others protest energetically against the falsehood, and say that it was circulated for a dishonest purpose.

The Spanish Colonial Minister has tendered to Captain General De Rodas reinforcements for the Cuban army, but the Captain General has declined them.
