The wife of President CESPEDES, of the Cuban Republic, is in Havana, whence, it is said, she will be permitted to come to this country. The capture of a bearer of important dispatches between Cubans in New-York and the insurgents in Cuba is announced from Havana. A Belgian named JOHN B.
