The Swatara at Santiago—Surrender of More Insurgent Chiefs and Soldiers —A Supposed Filibuster Expedition.

HAVANA, Jan. 31, via LAKE CITY, Jan. 31.-The United States steamer Swalara arrived at Santiago de Cuba yesterday. All well....Official dispatches aunounce the voluntary surrender, on Saturday, of the insurgent chief, ANDRES DOMINQUES, with four officers, seventy-two men armed with rifles, together with sixteen families. A party of fishermen saw lights off the coast of Mantua, in the Vuelta Abago District. They are supposed to have been the lights of some filibustering expedition. Nothing has been seen of them since. The insurgent Captain, SANTA PEREZ, with thirteen men, have surrendered to Major ARAGON. Reports from Nuevitas announce the surrender of the insurgent chief PERDOMO, the successor of MADRINAL, and 119 men.
