Reported Landing of Filibusters Denied —Insurgents Surrendering by the Thousand—The Carnival.

HAVANA, Feb. 19.—Reports were circulated that 700 filibusters had been landed at Vuelta Abajo, but the Government officially denies the truth of the report, and says it originated in the running aground of a Spanish gun-boat and the landing of the crew, who were mistaken for filibusters._...It is reported that a thousand persons presented themselves for surrender at Puerto Principe in one day, and that four hundred persons surrender daily in the Eastern Department....The carnival is an exceedingly animated one, and there is now an immense procession on the Plaza.
