CUBA.

Movements of Valmaseda — The Cuban War Minister Proposing to Surrender — Capture of the Records of an Insurgent Court-Martial—Sentence of Death of a Lady.

HAVANA, Feb. 22.—The British frigate *Royal Alfred*, Admiral FANSHAWE commanding, and attached to the West India flying squadron, has arrived here. Captain-General VALMASEDA returned today from Sancti Spiritus. The *Alba* newspaper, published at Villa Clara, says that Gen. AGUILERA, the Minister of War of the Cuban Republic, has made to VALMASEDA propositions to surrender. Among the documents captured from an insurgent Court-martial, is an account of the trial, sentence and hanging of Mme. CARIDAD MONTANER and LUIS ARGUIELAGOS. Their crime was trying to join the Spaniards. The sentence orders that out of respect to her sex, Mme. MONTANER, after execution, be buried with the clothing remaining on the corpse.
