

THE SPANISH WEST INDIES.

Another Engagement with the Cuban Insurgents—Unsettled State of Affairs in Porto Rico.

HAVANA, March 21.—In an engagement in the Cinco Villas the insurgent leader ANTONIO VILLEGAS surrendered, and the insurgent leader CAPOTES was killed. ANTONIO VILLEGAS, previous to surrendering, killed his companion, FERNANDEZ, who tried to surrender.Owing to the condition of affairs in Porto Rico Capt.-Gen.BALDRICH resigned and delivered his command to Gen. IZQUIERDO. The *Diario* of this city this morning treats of the Porto Rico question largely. It publishes a full manifest of the Conservative Spanish Party, and adds: "Cuba has a sufficient number of men and ships-of-war to send to Porto Rico in case of necessity."
