Execution of Rebels and Traitors—Crushing Out the Remnants of the Insurrection.

HAVANA, May 20.—JUAN MARQUEZ GARCIA, who had been convicted of treason, was executed at 6 o'clock this morning at Fort Cabanas. The Villa de Cobre shopkeepers who had been convicted of supplying the insurgents, have been executed at Santiago de Cuba. The insurgent Prefect, Capt. CARLOS VARONA, and the insurgent ENRIQUE FLOTAS, have been executed at Puerto Principe. Gen. ZEA reports having destroyed an insurgent camp on the 10th and killed five persons; that his troops killed on the 12th ELOY BEAUVILLIERS, an insurgent General of artillery, Capt. ANTO. BACHILLER MORLES, Adj. PEDRO LECERF, Lieut. PINEIRO and five others, and on the 13th the Ex-General-in-Chief of the Central Department, named BOUZA AGRAMONTE. Gen. ZEA also reports that he attacked VILLAMIL's forces on the 14th, and killed ten of them. The General returned on the 16th to Puerto Principe.
