Surrender of Insurgent Leaders—More Insubordination by the Volunteers.

HAVANA, June 14.—A number of families have surrendered at Santo Espiritus, including seventy men, within the past few days. Letters from prominent parties announce also the early surrender of several prominent insurgent leaders. Certain presentados and letters state positively that BEMBETA left without any official character or mission. VALMASEDA goes to Puerto Principe on the 17th or 18th. Four of the battalions of Havana volunteers refuse to send a company each to the military line. The other battalions have already designated the companies to go by lot.
