An American Colonel of Insurgents Killed — Valmaseda's New Military Tactics—Execution of Marmol Confirmed.

HAVANA, June 27.—CHARLES WESTROF, an American insurgent Colonel, has been killed. Capt.-Gen. VALMASEDA, in a proclamation, offers to pardon the Spanish deserters and grant them better terms of service if they deliver up their present chiefs dead or alive. He gives large rewards to those conducting the loyal troops to places where they can surprise the insurgent camps, and also to those contributing to the capture of the principal leaders of the insurrection. The execution of MARMOL is confirmed. The insurgent Generals, FERNANDO ESPINOSA and JOSE MENDOZA, the latter General of the celebrated "Cannao" Cavalry, surrendered today, with sixty-two armed Cubans and ninety other prisoners, at Las Parras.
