The Suppression of the Cuban Revolt Distasteful to the Opposition in the Cortes—Saxony.

Madrid, July 11.—The Cortes last night had a stormy session, which lasted until 2½ A. M. A motion was adopted to give the Government full support in its measures for the suppression of the insurrection in Cuba. The opposition abstained from voting.

Berlin, July 11.—The Saxon troops which served in the late war, made their triumphal entry into Dresden today. It was announced that the Emperor William had made the Crown Prince of Saxony a Field-Marshal of the Empire.
