

WEST INDIES.

Cuban Officials—Anxiety Regarding the Steamer *Port-au-Prince*—Capital of Jamaica to be Changed.

HAVANA, July 7.—VALMASEDA is at Sancti Espiritus; CEBOLLINO is sick with vomito, and VENENCE is the Acting Captain-General. Advices from Hayti to the 8th, state that fears were entertained for the safety of the steamer *Port-au-Prince* from New-York, which was then sixteen days overdue. Advices from Jamaica to the 6th, state that in two months the seat of Government will be removed from Spanish Town to Kingston. Lumber and shingles are much wanted, It is reported that the Government will not continue the arrangement with the Pacific mail steamers. The *Rising Star* will sail for New-York on the 7th. Commander SELF-RIDGE and other exploring officers are among her passengers.
