Important Surrender of Insurgent Chiefs.

HAVANA, Jan. 17, 1871,

The insurgent General Damain Madruga, Governor José Trujillo and Captain Salvador Rodríguez, the leaders of the Ciénaga de Zapale insurgents, and six others, surrendered yesterday to Commissioner Valmasedos. Rodríguez subsequently returned to bring in the rest of the insurgents. This surrender finishes the insurrection in the Ciénaga and Ensenada de Cichinos, and restores tranquility in the Colon district.
