HERALD SPECIAL REPORT FROM HAVANA.

Visit of Admiral Lee to the Spanish Authorities.

HAVANA, Feb. 9, 1871.

Rear Admiral S. P. Lee, commanding the United States North Atlantic squadron, and his staff, accompanied by Consul General Biddle, made an official call to-day upon Captain General Valmaseda and Admiral Malcampo, of the Spanish navy. They were received with marked attention. In the course of the interview which occurred Rear Admiral Lee took occasion to congratulate Valmaseda on the wisdom and clemency of the policy he was pursuing toward those rebels who saw fit to surrender themselves. Captain General Valmaseda replied with much courtesy.
