IMPORTANT SURRENDER EXPECTED

TELEGRAM TO THE NEW YORK HERALD.

HAVANA, Feb. 16, 1871.

The Captain General, Count Valmaseda, left to-day for the Department of Cinco Villas. On arrival there he will receive the submission of Villegas, the rebel chief of that district, who asks to surrender, but only to the Captain General in person.
