**Military Changes—Another Flight and a Few More Rebels Wiped Out—Rumors of Fighting and Landings and Their Consequences.**

HAVANA, MAY 20, 1891.

Caro has been relieved as Commander in Chief of the Central Department, and will return to Spain; Zea, his chief of staff, will be his successor.

The new Admiral, Nicolas Chicarrin, arrived yesterday.

News has been received of an engagement at Ladichosa, in which thirteen insurgents were killed and their intrenchments destroyed.

There are rumors from Villa Clara that 500 insurgents had attacked Oplenate, and that Quasada had landed an expedition near Trinklad; but the *Diario* asserts that the rumors are false.
