

**Surrender of Another Insurgent General—  
Opinions of the Havana Press on the Pro-  
posed Sale of Cuba.**

HAVANA, March 23, 1871.

The insurgent General Machado, with over sixty armed men surrendered to the Spaniards. Antonio Vellegas, who surrendered last week, acted as go between. This leaves two small bands of insurgents in the Cienfuegos district.

Long articles are published in the journals here protesting against the reported negotiations for the sale of Cuba and Porto Rico to the United States.
