

SEÑOR ALDAMA'S ESTATES—A CUBAN DIRECTORY.

Señor Miguel Do Aldama, President of the late Cuban Junta and at present Special Agent of the Cuban Government, states that the alleged Havana correspondence of a sensational morning journal relative to his disposing of his confiscated estates in Cuba to some Americans and the removal of the embargo thereon by the Spanish Government in consequence, is entirely untrue. He has never taken possession of his estates as his father died in this city willing his property to Aldama, and as he cannot go to Cuba, the will has never been admitted to probate, he being its custodian, and one of the executors. A Cuban Directory, consisting of delegates from all the cities where Cubans have congregated, is about to be formed for the better management of affairs relating to Cuba.
