Herald Special Report from Havana.

Prominent Insurgents Killed—The Rebel Guerillas Surprised and Defeated With Heavy Loss.

TELEGRAM TO THE NEW YORK HERALD.

HAVANA, April 22, 1871.

A telegram has been received from Captain General Valmaseda, dated Santi Espiritu, yesterday, in which it is stated that in a recent fight in which the column Castilla was engaged Miguel Geronimo Gutierrez, Vice President of the Cuban House of Representatives, and Miguel Valasco, quartermaster of the rebel army, were both killed.

A major portion of the rebel bands are being driven across the military line of Moron.

A despatch from Santiago de Cuba, dated to-day, states that Colonel Canzal surprised a rebel encampment near Cobre, killing twenty of them. Five prisoners were taken, who were immediately shot.
