Herald Special Report from Havana.

Insurgent Forces in the Santij Espiritu District Increasing.

Valmaseda in Hot Pursuit—Execution of Citizens Charged With Aid- ing the Insurgents.

TELEGRAMS TO THE NEW YORK HERALD.

HAVANA, April 24, 1871.

The HERALD correspondent at Santi Espiritu furnishes the following report of the condition of affairs in that region:—

There are more insurgent bands in this district than in the beginning of the insurrection. The majority have invaded this jurisdiction from Camaguey and destroyed much valuable property. Valmaseda, since his arrival, has been having them actively pursued, and has ordered many executions of citizens accused of aiding and abetting the insurgents.
