TELEGRAM TO THE NEW YORK HERALD.

HAVANA, May 12, 1871.

I have received intelligence from Sancti Spiritu, dated the 10th inst., to the effect that the Spanish column under Colonel Cadiz has routed a band of insurgents composed of negroes, coming from the Cinco Villas. Thirteen were killed on the field and four taken prisoners.
