The Insurrection Dying Out—Surrender of Insurgent Leaders—Movements of Captain General Valmaseda.

TELEGRAM TO THE NEW YORK HERALD.

HAVANA, July 1, 1871.

Among the surrendered Caunao officers are Nicolas Eloy and Oswaldo Adau, Melchor and Joseph E. Bernal, Filandro and Blas Rodriguez, Augustin and Porfirio Silva, Alfredo Betancourt and Augustin Coclo. The two brothers Adau were captured by General Agramonte.

It is reported that Generals Manuel Agramonte Porro and Josesito Roderiguez have made overtures for a surrender.

The Spanish party are making strenuous efforts to carry the Porto Rico elections.
