CUBA TO BE HELD WHILE MEN AND MONEY LAST.

MADRID, Thursday, June 22, 1871.

In the Cortes last evening the Minister of the Colonies declared that Spain would preserve the integrity of Cuba so long as men and arms were forthcoming. He admitted that there was a ministerial crisis, and added that the Cabinet would resign after the approval by the Cortes of the address of the Crown. All amendments to the address were withdrawn and the discussion proceeded.
