MOVEMENTS OF THE CAPTAIN-GENERAL—ESPINOSA WOUNDED.

HAVANA, June 23.—Valmaseda arrived at Vertientes yesterday, where he disembarked his troops, and is now marching toward Guayabal and Santa Cruz. Céspedes is at San Pedro, near Guaimaro.

The Cuban General, Luis Figuerro, with a large force, passed the Cauto River, accompanied by Gen. Pacheco, a son of Céspedes.

The Spanish Minister to Mexico has arrived at the capital. A telegraph line from Ciego de Avila to Jucarro has been established. The Cuban Captain Manuel Rodriguez has been killed.

A Cuban refugee led the Spaniards to Espinosa's encampment recently, and in the fight which ensued Espinosa was wounded and five of his party killed.
