AN AMERICAN COLONEL KILLED—REWARDS FOR CUBAN TRAITORS.

HAVANA, June 27.—Charles Westrop, an American, Colonel in the Cuban Service, has been killed. Captain-General Valmaseda, in a proclamation, offers to pardon the Spanish deserters, and grant them better terms of service, if they deliver up their present chiefs, dead or alive. He also offers large rewards to those conducting the Spanish troops to places where they can surprise the Cuban camps, and those contributing to the capture of the principal leaders of the insurrection. The execution of Marmol is confirmed.

The insurgent Generals Fernando Espinosa and Jose Mendez—the latter General of the celebrated "Cannoe" Cavalry—surrendered, to-day, with 62 armed Cubans and 10 other persons, at Las Parras.
